ROLE PURPOSE

The Student Representative will present the voice and opinions of student-athletes within Women's Rugby League, and act as an ambassador and key stakeholder in the future of the Women's Rugby League offer.

- Act as an ambassador for BUCS and the current Women's Rugby League offer.
- Establish relationships between BUCS and student-athletes within member institutions.
- Build and maintain a communication network with other students playing Rugby League.
- Advise the BUCS Sport Advisory Group (SAG) on all matters relating to the student perspective of BUCS Rugby League.
- Offer insight and feedback on the current Women's Rugby League structure and provide member led feedback to explore the future implementation of the programme into BUCS.
- Attend all relevant SAG meetings and provide any updates on actions from previous meetings.
