

# **BUCS TABLE TENNIS CHAMPIONSHIPS**

HOSTING REQUIREMENTS 2025-26, 2026-27 & 2027-28

### **Status**

The BUCS Table Tennis National Championships is the largest university table tennis competition in the UK. The event is held every academic year and is part of the competitive BUCS table tennis programme.

The event is held in November/December and fits within the national Table Tennis England calendar. The event is open to all BUCS affiliated member institutions from across the UK attracting widespread competition entries in both men's and women's categories. The event is a showcase for the very best university table tennis players, whilst also providing many university players with their first experience of a national competition.

#### **Format**

The Table Tennis National Championship is a three-day event (Friday to Sunday), in the following format:

- Friday: Men's, Women's & Mixed Doubles to conclusion
- Saturday: Men's & Women's Singles Groups
- Sunday: Men's & Women's Singles Knockouts to conclusion.

#### **Dates**

BUCS is seeking bids to host the Table Tennis National Championships for a three year period, in 2025-26, 2026-27 and 2027-28. For 2025-26, the preferred date due to clashes is 28<sup>th</sup> – 30<sup>th</sup> November 2025, but other dates will be considered if needed.

# **Host Venue**

The host venue would be expected to provide an indoor space that could accommodate 40 tables, with additional space for storing tables from the week of the event until the week after. It is also hoped that a venue could provide an additional space for between six and ten practice tables as close as possible to the main playing area, as well as a space for officials to eat and drink at lunch, dinner and any breaks they may have. Full details of all requirements, both essential and desirable, can be found in the accompanying bidding questionnaire.
