#### ROLE PURPOSE

The Student Representative will present the voice and opinions of student-athletes playing within Men's Netball in the HE Sector, act as an ambassador for the potential future BUCS Men's Netball programme and support the SAG in their efforts to add Men's Netball to the BUCS programme via the Sport Review Process.
