CODE OF CONDUCT

As an athlete, spectator and visitor to the University of Bath please respect the following code of conduct.

- Strictly no alcohol is allowed in the STV, Founders Hall or sports facilities and pitches. Any alcohol found will be confiscated.
- Respect each other, officials, staff, and security at all times, and listen to and act on instructions.
- No offensive chanting or foul language.
- Respect our facilities and leave areas as you found them.
- Entrance for all teams is via the main entrance of our Sports Training Village (STV). You must sign in when you arrive.
- Only use the changing room allocated to your team at the time allocated, and do not leave valuables or kit in the changing rooms whilst you are playing. Lockers are available in various locations across the Sports Training Village.
- All venues are entirely NO smoking or vaping areas.
- NO Pitch Invasions. Pitch invaders will be removed from the event and subject to disciplinary action.
- No behaviour that would bring your club, Students' Union, University or BUCS into disrepute at any point during the day will be tolerated.



GETTING HERE



Coaches

Teams travelling by coach must drop off at the end of our East Car Park; athletes must walk up to the STV entrance. Please note, **no** coaches are allowed to park in any car park, or drop off point, and please make sure you avoid our bus arrivals square. Coaches must drop off at the designated drop off point and then leave campus. They then can pick up from the back of the East Car Park when your team/s are ready to leave.

Cars & Minibuses

Please use the pay and display car parks when parking at the University. Due to strict restrictions, parking on residential streets around campus is **prohibited**. Please note, parking is limited and take extra time if traveling this way. You will be ticketed if you do not **pay and display.**

Public transport

Cost

Each institution will be invoiced by the University of Bath at a rate of £10 per player, per squad, based on the squad sizes submitted by BUCS (e.g., football has 16 squad members, so the entry fee would be $16 \times £10$). This payment will cover all event-related costs, including facility hire, match officials, first aid, and staffing.

Registration

Please can all teams arrive one hour before their fixture time to allow for sign-in and any enquiries. Once teams have arrived on campus, please go to the entrance of the STV for captains to sign their team in and to receive any information they need to know, including changing room allocation. If you arrive late, we may not be able to delay the start of the fixture due to facility constraints. Staff and volunteers will be present throughout the day and at all venues to answer any questions.

Teams competing in the Golf final, please note you do not have to sign in on campus. You can go straight to Bath Golf Club.

Fixture Schedule

Code of Conduct

The Code of Conduct has been included in this Event Guide – please see page 2. All athletes, spectators and visitors must always adhere to this Code of Conduct.



Spectators

Spectators are welcome however they must adhere to both the University of Bath and BUCS Code of Conduct. If any teams have any spectators a named staff member will be asked to attend and sign along with the team captain upon registration to confirm responsibility for their teams. The named member of staff must be always present at the venues with the spectators. Any behaviour that is deemed to be in breach of the Code of Conduct or BUCS Regulations will follow the breaches/sanctions.

Match Officials

University of Bath will appoint all Match Officials in line with Appendix 5 BUCS Match Officials Requirements.

Please treat all Match Officials with respect and in line with the Code of Conduct.

If a Match Official has not arrived for your fixture, please report to your Point of Contact at registration or the Event Lead, Sam Smith on 01225 386805.

Regulations

As well as respecting the officials, all teams must follow the BUCS Regulations. If there are any kit clashes, the named home team should change to an alternative kit, agreed by both institutions in advance, as per BUCS Regulations.

All teams must submit their BUCS Play team sheet and follow any of their NGB Regulations and the named home teams must submit the final score.

Weather

In the event of bad weather, pitch and venue inspections will take place and teams/institutions affected will be informed as soon as possible.

If the fixture cannot take place, the fixture will revert to the named home team and be played on another date agreed by both institutions as per BUCS Regulations.

Changing Rooms

Each team competing will be allocated a changing room before and after the fixture. Please note due to the scale of the event you may have to share with other teams. Once ready, each team must remove their items from the changing room and place them in the available lockers. All items are left at the owner's risk and the University of Bath take no liability for items being left.



Lost and Found

If any items are found, they will be taken to the STV Reception. To report a lost item, call the STV on 01225 384418.

Medal Ceremonies

These presentations will take place in two locations after each fixture – please see page 8. After your fixture is finished a volunteer/member of staff will take you to the presentation area – please take all your belongings with you. After your fixture, please make your way over to the presentation area promptly.

Catering and Refreshments

Campus has a wide variety of food and drink outlets which will be available on the day, including the STV Cafe and Limetree Cafe, which are the closest outlets to our sport facilities.

Parking and Travel

The University's main campus is located in Claverton Down, on the east side of Bath.

If you are using a satnav, use 'Norwood Avenue, Bath', not 'Quarry Road', to get to the main entrance of the campus and visitor car parks.

You can also search for 'admiral.salads.ages' on what3words.

Medical Provision
